Fall/Submission 1

Fall data include:

- ◆ **snapshot data** - data reflect the status of the district on October 30, 2009. These data include budget, staff, organization, and student data.
- ◆ **leaver data** - data on graduates, dropouts, and other school leavers identified during the 2008-2009 school year.

Fall data are used to:

- ◆ calculate compensatory entitlement,
- ◆ monitor special programs,
- ◆ report to the federal government,
- ◆ calculate retention,
- ◆ calculate basic profiles for AEIS, and
- ◆ perform desk audits.

- ◆ calculate FSP final allotments,
- ◆ calculate attendance and course completion,
- ◆ create a portion of the AEIS,
- ◆ augment the monitoring of special programs, and
- ◆ perform desk audits.
