Program Description

The purpose of the Target Tech in Texas Collaborative Grant – American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 is to solicit grant applications from eligible applicants to implement programs that will stimulate the use of educational technology to improve teaching and learning. Grant funds are to be used to assist schools in providing 21st century classrooms as envisioned by the Long-Range Plan for Technology, 2006-2020 (LRPT); available online at (<http://ritter.tea.state.tx.us/technology/lrpt/LRPTCompleteDec06.pdf>). The LRPT is designed to guide Texas LEAs in the effective use of technology to prepare students to learn and work in the 21st century. To achieve this goal, Texas schools must assess their technology needs and implement programs that make substantial progress in meeting the Target Tech level on the Texas Campus and Teacher School Technology and Readiness (STaR) Charts. Providing students with the necessary, more advanced technologies, educational technology programs and practices, and well-trained teachers, will enable schools to use innovative teaching strategies designed to engage students and promote critical thinking, problem solving, creativity, and college and career readiness.

Eligibility

Funding under the Target Tech in Texas Collaborative Grant - ARRA is available to A) a high-need local educational agency; or (B) an eligible collaborative. All applicants must meet the eligibility requirements that apply to their type of organization in order to be eligible to apply for funding as part of the collaborative.
